







<u>CLUB HISTORY</u> - Jo Cornstubble gave a history of an aspect of our club.


<u>HOSTS RECOGNIZED</u> – Juana Smith thanked everyone for the potluck, next month is our catered Christmas Party.



DECEMBER 6, 2025

REQUIREMENTS TO PARTICIPATE

- 1. Entrants must be in their parking space by 4:30 p.m.
 - Participants will be checked by Parade Staff to ensure all "Parade Entry Rules" and "Judging Rules" are followed.
 - i. Participants will not be admitted to the parade staging after 5pm.
- 2. ENTRANTS MAY NOT HAND OUT CANDY OR OTHER ITEMS ALONG PARADE ROUTE.
- 3. Taging time will be between 3:00 and 4:30pm.
- 4. Children walking in the parade must be accompanied by an adult.
- 5. All pets/animals in the parade must be entered and associated with an approved animal organization.
 - a. For example: P.A.W.S., Adopt-A-Pet, etc
- 6. All local, state, and federal laws will apply for this event.
- Majority of vehicles and floats must have holiday lights and decorations to be accepted as an entry.
- 8. Car/Motorcycle clubs; a max of six (6) vehicles allowed per entry. Please limit one entry per car club.


GUIDELINES FOR JUDGING

- 1. The following overall awards will be presented:
 - -Best In Show
 - -Best Use of Lights

- -Best Holiday Spirit
- -Best Sounding Middle School Band
- -Best Sounding High School Band
- Best Car/Motorcycle Club
- 2. To be considered for any of the six overall awards, entries must meet all of the following criteria:
 - The entry must have working holiday lights and/or
 - The entry must be only playing holiday music.
- 3. In order to avoid gaps throughout the parade, all entries must keep a steady pace on the parade route.
- Judging will be done during the parade. Awards will be mailed or delivered to the winning entries on the week of December 9th to the address listed on your entry form.
- * We reserve the right to deny application or disqualify from the parade
- *All vehicles/floats must bbe decorated at least 70% with holiday lights and decorations.
- * THE CITY OF VICTORIA WILL SUPPLY THE ONE AND ONLY SANTA CLAUS.


